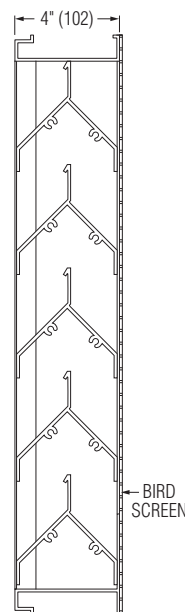

First Baptist Church Oklahoma was founded in 1889. The sanctuary building was built in 1912 with the popular Gothic style of the day. The education building was added to the site in 1952. Their list of previous pastors includes Mordecai Ham, who is credited with bringing Billy Graham to Christ.

In 2014, the louvers mounted on the church towers needed replacement. First Baptist chose Nailor to manufacture the custom aluminum louver to match the existing shape, appearance, and exceed the existing durability. Working with the architect and equipment representative the Nailor 1604Y louver blade design was chosen. The 1604Y blade is ideal for louvers requiring sightproof, or inability to see through the louver at any angle. The sightproof blade design features a center water baffle that performs adequately under wind driven rain conditions. The standard concealed architectural mullions allow for a smooth, continuous look and reinforcing bosses run the length of each blade for superior strength.
